behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Binod Kumar, learned A.P.P.

appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Fatuha P.S. Case No. 492 of 2022 for the offence
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504, 506 and 34 of
Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution story, in brief, is that the allegation
against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused
persons assaulted the informant and his son and also used filthy
language.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that the genesis of the alleged incidence is
because the petitioner had protested against giving illegal



electricity connection from his legal connection from the Power Holding Company. The allegations against the petitioner is general and omnibus in nature. Learned counsel further submitted that there is no direct and specific allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. Considering the nature of allegation made in the F.I.R. as well as the fact that the informant has not given details of the electricity connection which they are using. In view of the above matter it appears that the petitioner has made out a *prima facie* case to released on pre-arrest bail.

6. The Court below is directed to release the petitioner on anticipatory bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. Ist, Patna city in connection with Fatuha P.S. Case NO. 492 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

7. The present bail application is disposed of.
