- 2 01-09-2023 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 3126 of 2018, which has stood dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 26.07.2022.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Advocate on Record of the
