6 24-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Patahi P.S. Case No. 22 of 2022 registered under Sections
420, 409 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is owner of the Tent House. He is
innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. The
petitioner has supplied the items as demanded by co-accused
Santosh Sah at four quarantine centres at different Schools. The
Principals of the Schools duly verified and issued certificates to
the effect that the petitioner has supplied the materials in
quarantine centres, as is evident from Annexure-2 series of the
bail application. Further he submits that petitioner has no



criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of C.J.M., East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 22 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
