Nor seeking extension of time to comply the order before the lapse of time limit



stipulated by this Court. Further, there is a delay of more than one year in complying the orders of this Court, therefore, the respondents are liable to pay litigation cost.

2. Litigation cost is quantified at Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand). Cost shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

3. Accordingly, contempt petition stands dropped.
