APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Section 395, 397, 412 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown miscreants
stopped the Train No. 08623 between Bela and Nadaul Station
and entered into the Train and snatched the mobile phones of the
passengers and also beaten them with bricks and stones.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and
the same has been lodged against unknown persons. The name
of the petitioner has come into light, on the basis of confessional



statement of co-accused, which has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. Nothing incriminating/looted articles have been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. No T.I. Parade has been done. He further submitted that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. He is languishing in judicial custody since 30.05.2023.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Jehanabad Rail P.S. Case No. 34 of 2021.
