- 2 01-11-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 2314 of 2022, C.I.S. No. 1281 of 2023 registered under Sections 341, 323, 354 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive. Further he submits that in the instant case, the complaint case is filed after lapse of two weeks of the alleged occurrence. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.
4. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Purnea in connection with Complaint Case No. 2314 of 2022, CIS No.
