counsel for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Rajgir P.S. Case No. 536 of 2022 registered for the offences
under Sections 498(A) and 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
instant case. Further submission is that there is no specific
allegation against the petitioner. Petitioner is father-in-law of the
deceased. Further submission is that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent.
