A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No.223 of 2021 registered under Sections 413, 414, 34, 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The theft truck was recovered from the shop of Jhalak Sah. The apprehended accused disclosed the name of the petitioner.
