ORAL ORDER

2 23-06-2023 The petitioner is aggrieved by selection of respondent

No. 8 as *Vikas Mitra* by Sub-Divisional Officer, Bihar Sharif,

under the scheme of *Mahadalit Vikash Mission*.

The uncontroverted averment in the counter-affidavit
is that the petitioner belongs to caste "*Parsi*" whereas the
selection of respondent No. 8 was on basis of her caste being
"*Musahar*", as the *Panchayat Dhanuki* was predominantly
comprised of "*Musahar*" caste and under the scheme, selection
was to be made from the predominant caste.



In view of this uncontroverted situation emerging from the pleadings, no right of the petitioner is made out to claim selection as she does not belong to the predominant caste.

Writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
