petitioner and learned A.C. to Standing Counsel-25 for the State.

Petitioner is aggrieved by the order passed by Circle Officer, Baniyapur, Saran, Chhapra on remand by the Additional Collector, Saran (Chhapra). According to the petitioner the Circle Officer, Baniyapur, Saran, Chhapra has passed different order dated 20.10.2017, which has been impugned in the present writ application.

Learned counsel for the State submits that against the order of Circle Officer, there is a provision of appeal before the Deputy Collector, Land Reforms.



Accordingly, this writ application is disposed with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order of the Circle Officer before the appellate authority in accordance with law.
