seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this application is for issuance
of an appropriate writ or writs, order or
orders, direction or directions and



thereby to quash the order dated 13.8.2013 passed by Sub Judge III, Buxar in Title Suit No.72 of 2008 by which the learned trial court has rejected the petition dated 11.4.2013 filed by petitioners for deleting Schedule I property of the suit to the extent of 8 Acres 98 decimals of village Jaso P.S. Buxar, district Buxar and for a direction to the office of the court to delete these properties as per earlier order of the court dated 12.3.2013.”
