Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
C.R. No.953 of 2018 registered under Sections 363, 364 and 34
of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this
case. It is submitted that earlier the present petitioner no.2
lodged F.I.R. against the present complainant and his family
members as is evident from Annexure 2. Petitioners have got no



criminal antecedent.
