2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 504 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegation against the petitioner is that he assaulted the informant's father and also informant's brother due to which they sustained injuries and the reason behind this as alleged occurrence is said to be land dispute.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. There is case and counter case between both the parties and both parties have sustained injuries as alleged in separate occurrence. Moreover, the



petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 07.07.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Shakurabad P.S. Case No. 113 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Jehanabad.
