3. Learned counsel for the State submits that all petitioners are daily wager since 01.01.2009 and as per Circular No.639 dated 16.03.2006, those working prior to cut off date fixed, i.e., 11.12.1990, are entitled for regularization and, as such, there is no case of the petitioners.

4. Since no one appears on behalf of the petitioners, therefore, this case is dismissed for non-prosecution.
