2 12-01-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 457, 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he damaged the CCTV camera and entered into the house of informant and took away golden ornaments and cash.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He further submits that a litigation was going



on between the parties and a proceeding under section 107 Cr.PC was initiated against the informant. Petitioner has two criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is previous enmity between the parties, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Kotwali (Gaya) P.S. Case No.262 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
