2 19-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.
Arun Kumar, learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Bodhgaya P.S. Case No. 251 of 2023 for the offence under
Sections 304B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the petitioner along with his family
members killed the deceased for demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased and he has got no
criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 21.06.2023. He
further submits that he has falsely been implicated in this case.

Petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased and
there is a general and omnibus allegation levelled against him.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent and period of custody, the petitioner, named



above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. Ist Class, Gaya in connection with Bodhgaya P.S. Case No. 251 of 2023.
