2 16-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341,323,325,307,504,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution's case in short is that due to petty dispute a free fight took place between the parties on account of which two cases were instituted each by either parties.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Injuries sustained by the injured in this



case have been found to be simple in nature. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of dispute against the petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate I, Aurangabad in Salaiya Police Station Case No. 47 of 2022/GR No.1254 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
