ORAL ORDER

A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Jandaha P.S. Case No. 164 of 2023 dated 31.5.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 395, 397, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 25(1-b)a and 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, three miscreants riding on two motorcycles came and demanded all belongings from the informant and further, one of the miscreants assaulted with the butt of pistol to the friend of the informant namely Amresh causing injury. Further, they snatched Rs. 27,000/-, Aadhar Card, Driving License, ATM card etc. from the informant and fled away.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. His name has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused Raushan. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 8.6.2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Jandaha P.S. Case No. 164 of 2023.

7. The application stands allowed.
