After some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a representation with respect to their grievances raised in the writ petition, before the Director-in-Chief, Directorate of Health Services, Bihar at Patna (respondent no.3).

Let the petitioners file such representation before respondent no.3 within a period of four weeks from today.

In the event such representation is filed by the petitioners, respondent no.3 shall look into the matter and dispose of the same in accordance with law by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of further three months.

Writ petition stands withdrawn with the aforesaid observation.
