“1. That this application is being filed seeking the kind indulgence of their Lordships to quash the order dated 19.01.2016 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge-6, Gopalganj in Sessions Trial No. 181 of 2013 (arising out of Mahammadpur P.S. Case No. 08 of 2012). By the impugned order, the discharge petition of petitioners has
