5 22-03-2023 Heard Mr. Bhola Prasad, learned counsel appearing
on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Nagendra Prasad, learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Sessions Trial No.82/2022 arising out of Falka P.S.Case
No.459/2018, registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 394, 302 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of
the Arms Act.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State
informs this Court that only few witnesses are left to be
examined and it seems that the trial is likely to be concluded
very soon.

4. Further, in compliance of order of this Court, the
learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-IV, Katihar has



informed through letter no. 103/2022 dated 05.12.2022 that there is considerable progress in the trial and it is likely to be concluded within a very short span of time.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has informed this Court that the informant has become hostile.

6. Considering the aforesaid development, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

7. Accordingly, the present bail application is disposed of.
