APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 365, 302, 201 and
120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the son of the informant is
alleged to have been killed by the petitioner in connivance with
other accused persons.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on the
basis of suspicion. He has committed no offence. He submitted
that the police after investigation has submitted final form in
favour of the petitioner but the learned Chief Judicial



Magistrate, Madhepura deferring with the police report erroneously taken cognizance against the petitioner. Save and except the suspicion, there is no cogent material has surfaced during course of investigation to show that the petitioner has involved in the alleged occurrence. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail petition. He is languishing in judicial custody since 19.10.2022.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-II, Madhepura in connection with Kumar Khand P.S. Case No. 356 of 2022.
