3. Grievance of the petitioner is relating to certain encroachments. In this regard, official respondents have taken action to register encroachment case and it was decided on 20th December, 2017. Thereafter, certain encroachers approached the authority by filing appeal and it was disposed of on 03.09.2019. Consequently, official respondents proceeded to remove the



encroachments on 04.12.2019.

Contempt Petition stands dropped. If anything is left out in not
undertaking the removal of encroachment, petitioner is at liberty
to file fresh writ petition.
