counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Complaint Case No. 707 C of 2018 for the alleged offences
under section 498A of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3/4 of
the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the
complaint and he has been falsely implicated in this case.
Petitioner undertakes to pay Rs. 1000/- per month to the
opposite party no. 2, as stated in the supplementary affidavit
filed on behalf of the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal



antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai in connection with Complaint Case No. 707C of 2018 subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
