3 28-02-2023 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and perused the case diary.

The petitioner is in custody in a case registered for offences punishable under Sections 342, 376, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act and 4 and 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses Act, 2012.
