ORAL ORDER

5 08-05-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304-B, 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioners is that they alongwith other co-accused persons killed the daughter of the informant due to non-fulfillment of demand for dowry.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather



general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners. The petitioners are the mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased. It is submitted that the informant and his family members had participated in the cremation of the deceased. She further submits that the present FIR has been lodged after a lapse of one month of the death of the deceased. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No.125 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
