construction of Nala (Drainage) from the house of sanitary sany to Dinesh Singh under Ward no.2 in Panchayat Bhanub, Block-Obra, District Aurangabad as per the work order by preparing final bill for the financial year 2020-21 as against estimated cost amounting to Rs. 13,29,600/-."
