Pramod Kumar Pandey, learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 387 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. As per prosecution case, mobile holder of the No.
7004113133 demanded *rangdari* of Rs. 5 lacs from the
informant and threatened him to suffer with dire consequences if
the same was not paid.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is not owner of the mobile as detailed in the F.I.R.
and his name has transpired only on the basis of confessional
statement of co-accused.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the bail



application and submits that petitioner has got two criminal antecedents of similar nature.

6. Considering the criminal antecedents of similar nature, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
