Ehteshamuddin, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Mahila Naugachhiya P.S. Case No. 7 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 336(A), 376, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 4 of the POCSO Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is an accused of abducting the victim girl.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. From the reading of the statement of the victim under Section 164 Cr. P.C., it appears that the petitioner and the victim were in a relationship.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Judge (POCSO)-cum-7th Additional District & Sessions Judge, Bhagalpur in connection with Mahila (Naugachhiya) P.S. Case No. 7 of 2013.
