following relief:-

“1.That the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Hon’ble Court for issuance of an appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction(s) for commanding to the respondents concern to act in a true spirit and prospective of the agreement entered between the parties and as such forthwith clear the outstanding admitted dues amount of the petitioner for the



work construction of two room building at High School at Sultanpur in Mohiuddin Nagar Block under RSVY for the year 2008-2009 (2007-08). Measurement of work done measured, checked and passed by the competent authority.”

The concerned respondent was required to settle certain dues arising out of contract with the petitioner. In this regard, the petitioner has issued a notice *vide* Annexure-5 however, legal notice, lacks the name of the addressee, i.e., the person to whom it has been addressed. In fact the addressee has been left blank and therefore, the writ petition itself is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed reserving liberty to the petitioner to invoke appropriate remedy.
