A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Gwalpara (Arar O.P.) P.S. Case No.177 of 2021 registered
under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 354, 315, 504, 379/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. It is
submitted that similarly situated co-accused has been granted
anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 03.01.2023
