ORAL ORDER

2 18-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 424 of 2023 dated 05.07.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 272, 273, 420 and 120B read with section 34 of the IPC and sections 30(a), 32(2), 32(3), 33, 36, 41(1) and 41(2) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 300 litres of illicit spirit was recovered from a Bolero vehicle and the apprehended accused persons disclosed the name of the other persons who were involved as Umesh Sahni, Mukesh Rai, Sanjo Rai (Petitioner) and Arvind Rai.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not the owner of the said vehicle. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is accused in one more criminal case as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 21.08.2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Muzaffarpur in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No. 424 of 2023.

7. The application stands allowed.
