2 17-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 385/379/435/427/504/506 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

Prosecution's case in short is that petitioners and other accused persons abused and assaulted the informant. They are also alleged to have made firing in air and scattered and damaged articles of the shopkeepers of worth Rs.2 lacs.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits



that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case as parties are on litigating terms from before due to old enmity and land dispute. There is general and omnibus allegation of assault against the accused persons and no specific overt act has been alleged against the petitioners. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate I, Samastipur in Tajpur Police Station Case No. 91 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
