ORAL ORDER

2 07-11-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 147, 149, 341, 323, 307, 504, 506 of the IPC and subsequently section 302 IPC was added.

3. Allegedly, the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioners assaulted the informant's side by means of several weapons due to which they got injured and one of the injured died in course of treatment.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such



occurrence in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is case and counter-case between the parties and both sides have sustained injuries. Petitioners are only the member of the mob and similarly situated co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 01.11.2023, passed in Cr. Misc. No.65755 of 2023. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Mehandia P.S. Case No.21 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
