ORAL ORDER

2 13-10-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Sessions Trial No. 286 of 2023 arising out of K. Nagar
(Maranga) P.S. Case No. 344 of 2021, lodged under Sections
363, 365, 366 and 379 of the I.P.C.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
bail application of the petitioner has earlier been rejected vide
order dated 06.09.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 44487 of 2023
in which liberty was granted to him to renew his prayer for bail
after framing of charge.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits
that the charge has already been framed in this case on

28.08.2023.

5. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that it is true that the charge has already been framed in this case.

6. In the present facts and circumstances of this case and the submissions made above, let the petitioner above named, be granted bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Purnea in connection with Sessions Trial No. 286 of 2023 arising out of K. Nagar (Maranga) P.S. Case No. 344 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 437(3) of Cr.P.C. with other following conditions:

(i) one of the bailor should be the family member of the petitioner who shall provide official document to show his *bona fide*;

(ii) the petitioner shall appear on each and every date before the Trial Court and failure to do so for two consecutive dates without plausible reason will entail cancellation of his bail bonds by the Trial Court itself;

(iii) the petitioner shall appear before the concerned police station every month for one year to mark attendance;

(iv) the petitioner shall in no way try to induce or promise or threat the witnesses or tamper with the evidence, failing which the State shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail bonds; and

(v) the petitioner shall desist from committing any criminal offence again, failing which the State shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of the bail bonds.

7. With this observation, the bail application stands allowed.
