A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Paroo P.S. Case No.60 of 2022 registered under Sections
304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this
case. He further submits that there is no specific allegation
against the petitioners. The husband of the deceased is in
custody. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances
of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the
