seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1. a) For a direction upon the
respondent authorities not to
initiate successive prohibitory
proceedings against the petitioner*



for cultivating and entering the land situated at Mauja Bajitpur (Circle Vidyapatinagar, District Samastipur) and subject matter of Land Ceiling Case No. 40/1973-74 without scrutinizing the adverse claims, if any, strictly in accordance law with

b) For a direction upon the respondent authorities to take preventive action and restrain respondent no. 11 and his associates from interfering with the settled peaceful possession of petitioner's family with respect of the land situated at Mauja-Bajitpur (Circle-Vidyapatinagar, District-Samastipur) and subject matter of Land Ceiling Case No. 40/1973-74.

c) For a direction upon the respondent authorities to perform their statutory duty and thwart anti-social activities of Respondent No. 11 and his associates and provide adequate security to the petitioner to enjoy peaceful possession and usufructs of land belonging to the petitioner without any interference



whatsoever, in accordance with law.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of his grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
