ORAL ORDER

2 20-06-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That application is being filed for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus direction to Respondents concerned to pay compensation amount to the petitioner on the death of her son namely Kunal Kumar Bhagat in rail accident and any other appropriate writ, order, save and except in accordance of law.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks
