ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2023 Heard both the parties.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of her arrest in connection with Bhore P.S. Case No. 529 of 2021, dated 02.12.2021, instituted for the offences under Sections- 366-A, 376(3), 342, 504, 506/34 of I.P.C. and 4/6 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

3. Learned APP opposes the prayer of anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

4. The allegation against the accused petitioner is of providing place where it is stated that the other co-accused had taken the prosecutrix who is said to have been abducted by the relatives of the petitioner.

5. Looking into the statement of the prosecutrix where



there is no allegation of any overt act as against the petitioner, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, namely Rampati Devi, and in the event of arrest, she shall be released on bail, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C., which are held as under:-

(i) The petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and make herself available for interrogation, whenever required;

(ii) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any witness acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer;

(iii) The petitioner shall not obstruct or hamper the police investigation and not play mischief with the evidence collected or yet to be collected by the police;

(iv) The petitioner shall maintain law and order;

(v) The petitioner shall, at the time of execution of the bond, furnish her address and mobile number to the investigating officer, and the court concerned, and shall not change the residence till the final disposal of the case;

(vi) The petitioner shall surrender his passport, if any, before the investigating officer within a week and, if she does



not possess any passport, she shall file an affidavit to that effect
before the investigating officer;

(vii) The petitioner shall regularly remain present
during the trial and cooperate with the Hon'ble Court to
complete the trial for the above offences.
