2 11-05-2023 Petition for pre-arrest bail of petitioner no.2 is
dismissed as withdrawn.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner no. 1 apprehends arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under sections 379/307/34
and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, all the FIR named
accused persons including the petitioner assaulted the informant
with sword and looted cash from the shop of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
parties are agnates and there is case and counter case. Doctor
has found simple injuries. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.



Considering the aforesaid facts of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner no.1 is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner no.1, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate III, Vaishali at Hajipur in Jurawanpur Police Station Case No. 109 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
