ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 354, 379, 307, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioners is that they alongwith other co-accused persons assaulted the informant's side by means of several weapons due to which they sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever



taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Petitioner no.1 is the own brother and petitioner no.2 is the nephew of the informant. He further submits that from the perusal of the injury report, it is clear that the injuries are found to be simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Laukariya P.S. Case No.72 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
