APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 418, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 66 of the I.T. Act.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that when the informant got secret information about inter state gang of Cyber criminals gathered at Mahavir temple and planning to commit some offence, he along with police personnel raided the place of occurrence and apprehended the accused persons including the petitioner. On search, three Paytm POS machine along with mobile phones have been recovered from them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has



falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of suspicion. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner and so far seized motorcycle is concerned, the same is his own motorcycle. He has got no criminal antecedent. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused namely, Ujjawal Raj has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 27.2.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 68470 of 2022. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 10.8.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 446 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna.
