ORAL ORDER

8 22-02-2023 CWJC No. 20157 of 2016 stood dismissed for default by an order dated 06.09.2019. It appears that a supplementary affidavit has been filed in the present restoration application stating therein that respondent No. 4 of the said CWJC No. 20157 of 2016 is no more and accordingly it has been stated that in his place, name of his son, namely, Sri Rakesh Kumar be substituted after expunging his name.
