ORAL ORDER

4 12-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief :-

“(i) For issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 07.10.2022, passed by Assistant Inspector General of Registration, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga in Stamp case no. 192/2022-23 by which he has accepted the report/ recommendation of sub-registrar, Benipatti which says that nature of land is residential and accordingly, he has directed the petitioner to deposit Rs. 2,06,334/- deficit stamp and Rs. 20,634/- as penalty.”



Considering the fact that the order dated 07.10.2022, passed in Stamp case no. 192 of 2022-23 by the respondent no. 3 i.e. the Assistant Inspector General of Registration, Darbhanga Division, Darbhanga is patently illegal, the same has been withdrawn by the respondent no. 3 by an order dated 11.04.2023, a copy whereof has been produced before this Court and is kept on record.

Accordingly, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, hence stands disposed off.
