2 26-06-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“For issuance of appropriate writ/order or direction commanding the Respondents particularly Respondent No. 7 to 9 to make payment of due amount of Rs.105000/-



to the petitioner with 18% penal interest at the same has wrongly been kept by the Respondents No. 7 to 9?”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Sheohar, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the District Magistrate, District-Sheohar by filing appropriate representation, within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
