2 06-11-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners have prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

The petitioners are alleged to have been apprehended with a four vehicle bearing Reg. No. UP27L-4653 from where, 127.8 liters illicit foreign liquor was recovered.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners have submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. They have got no criminal antecedent. Petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery or with the vehicle in question. No any incriminating article has been recovered from



their possession. The petitioners are languishing in judicial custody since 21.9.2023.

Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of Bail.

The petitioners are directed to deposit a sum of **Rs 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each** in the District Legal Services Authority of concerned District.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail in connection with Pranpur (Roshna) P.S. Case No. 178 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Exclusive Special Excise, court No.2, Katihari.

The bail bonds of the petitioners shall be accepted by the learned court below on showing separate receipt of deposit of **Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) by each petitioner** in the account of the concerned DLSA.
