Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2023 in
connection with N.H. Bangara P.S. Case No. 101/2023
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 25(1-b)
a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, three live cartridges
have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He further
submits that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal
antecedents.



5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Samastipur, in connection with N.H. Bangra P.S. Case No. 101/2023.

7. The petitioner is directed to mark his attendance in Pusa police station on 1st Sunday of every month.

8. It is made clear that any default in appearance in the aforesaid police station, as directed, would result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
