2 06-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 41(1) and (2) of the
Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2022.

Allegedly, it is a case of recovery of 454.710 liters of
illicit liquor from an open field.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He
further submits that he has no concern with the seized liquor
and no any incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious possession of the petitioner as well as petitioner is in
judicial custody since 15.09.2022 and petitioner has clean
antecedent.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise Court No.II, Samastipur in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 442 of 2022.
