A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Bhore P.S.
Case No. 284 of 2023 registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code
pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate,
Gopalganj.

3. As per the prosecution case, the allegation
against the petitioner is of cheating, misappropriation of money
of Government Exchequer and interpolation in the
document/fake vouchers.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not



specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that no where it has been stated that vouchers in question have been compared to the original and no enquiry has been done and only upon the report of the sale tax department the present FIR has been lodged. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the petitioner is also involved in the present case. Hence, he does not deserve privilege of anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.

7. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the learned Court below within six weeks from today and seek regular bail, the learned Court below would pass order on the same day in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
