The petitioner by way of this writ petition prays for
directing the District Teachers Appointment Appellate Authority,
Siwan, to dispose of the appeal of the petitioner.

In the opinion of this Court, day-to-day functioning of
the judicial/quasi judicial authorities ought not be interfered by
this Court by exercising jurisdiction under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India. Each Court has method of working and



taking-up of cases has to be exclusively as per the procedure laid down. If any person wants case to be listed out of turn, appropriate application can be moved in that judicial forum for the said purpose. The writ petition would not lie as this Court can not be converted into a Court of supervision and hearing early listing application.

The writ petition is misconceived and is, accordingly, dismissed.
